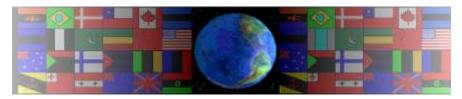

You are to design a board game based on the theme GOOD CITIZEN. The game must be interesting, informative and enjoyable. The player wins by being the best citizen.

Cartoon characters may be involved. These may be existing characters or characters of your own design/creation. Famous people may be involved or famous places.

A range of accessories may be needed such as counters.
