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Designers often find inspiration through the use of moodboards. A designer has put together a moodboard, with the theme 'Africa' (seen below).

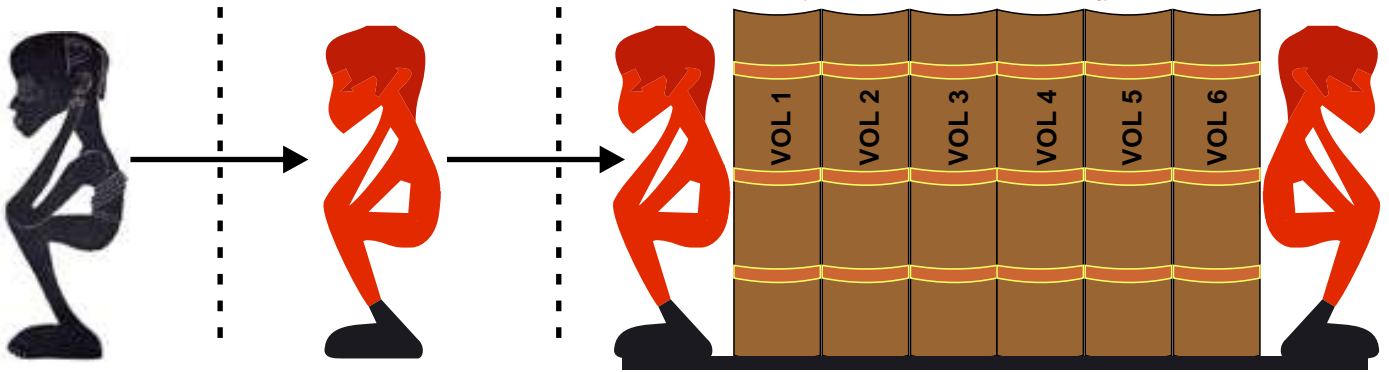
Study the moodboard carefully and then select two of the following pieces of furniture:

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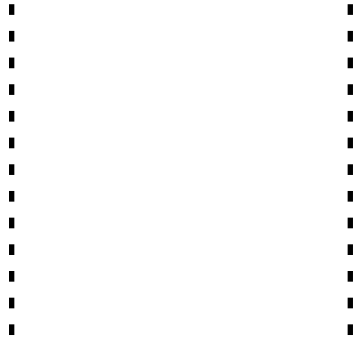


Basic image / engraving copied from moodboard.
