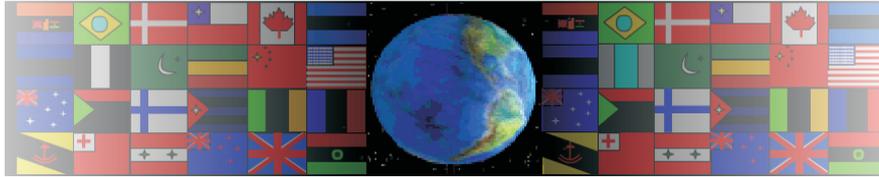

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

You are to design the layout of a mobile phone for a typical teenager.


1. Remember, mobile phones can have numerous functions. However, the needs of a teenage customer may restrict the number of functions required for the final layout of each phone.
