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1. Sketch a dead centre and live centre. Explain the difference between both.

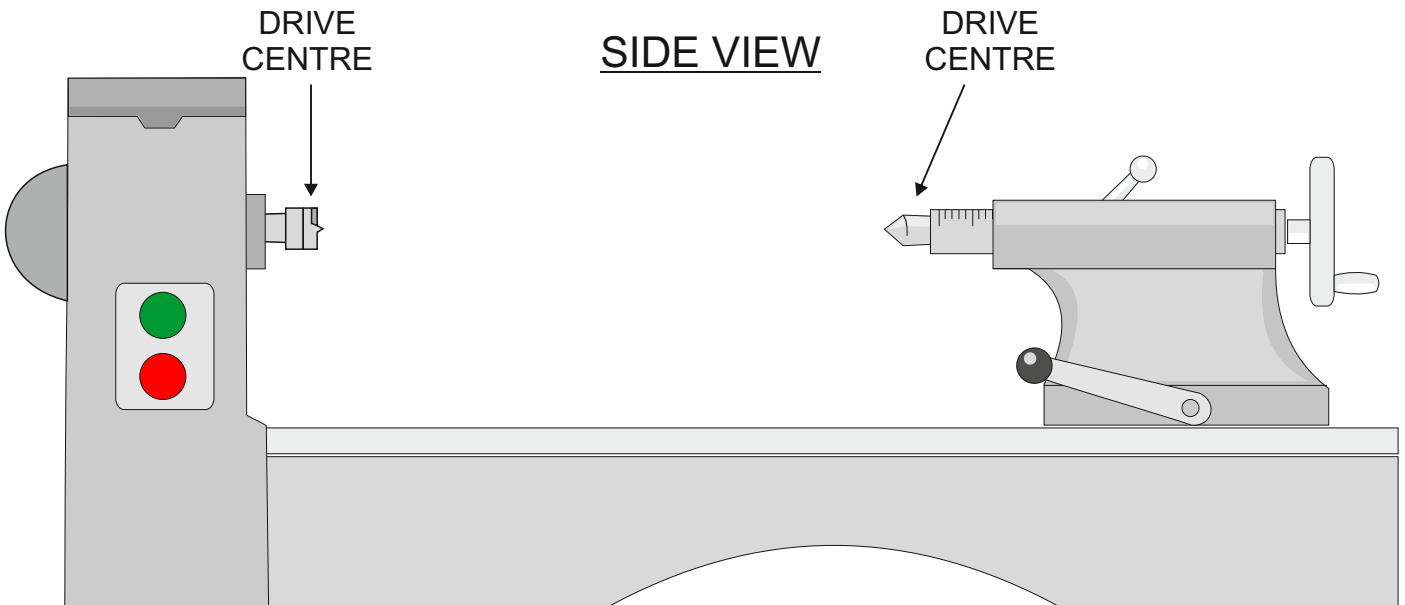
