*PVA is suitable of a wide variety of woods. (Polyvinyl Acetate also known as, PVA and PVAc). It is probably the most common wood glue, used extensively in furniture manufacture and construction.*

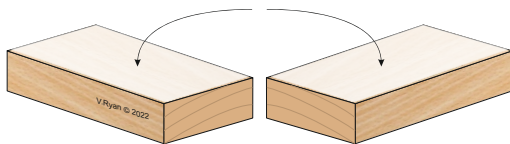

Use a plastic spreader or a brush to spread the glue across the surfaces of both pieces. The glue should be spread thinly. Clean up any spills with a damp cloth.

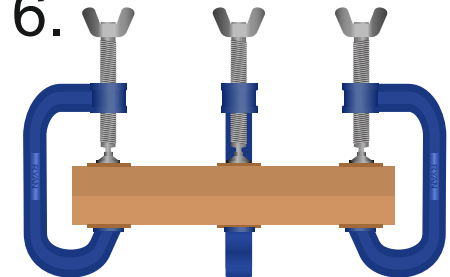

Push the two pieces together, rubbing the surfaces from side to side. This will ensure that air is not trapped and that the glue has been spread evenly.
