
ARCHITECTURAL PICTORIAL VIEW - MODULAR, AFFORDABLE HOUSING

You are to design a small modular home, suitable for two people. It can be regarded as a 'starter home', the first affordable home that a typical person / couple purchases. Your design must be open plan, with potential use of partitions to isolate areas of floor space (for example, the sleeping area). Your 'home' should have all the essential fixtures and fittings. The building must be constructed sustainably and be environmentally friendly. A parking space and a garden / area of relaxation, are also essential.

THE HOUSE HAS SUPER FAST **INTERNET AND** SATELLITE COMMUNICATIONS.

RECYCLED AND RECONDITIONED TIMBER CLADDING.

THE WINDOWS ARE **DESIGNED TO RETAIN** HEAT WITHIN THE HOUSE IN WINTER.

THEY CAN BE ADJUSTED ELECTRONICALLY, SO THAT DIRECT HEAT FROM THE SUN IS **REFLECTED AWAY,** HELPING TO KEEP THE HOUSE COOL IN THE SUMMER.

KNOWN AS LOW-EMISSIVITY (LOW-E) WINDOWS.
