3. Jeff the bully has decided to get his friends to shout names at two girls in the playground. You have heard him organising his friends. He intends for his group to follow the girls and get his friends to call out the names. What would you do?

4. Jeff and his friends have started pushing around Year 7 pupils unless they give him their money. They are calling this 'the bullies tax'. What would you do?

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5. Describe an example of bullying you have witnessed.

Explain how you felt when you saw the bullying incident you have described above.
