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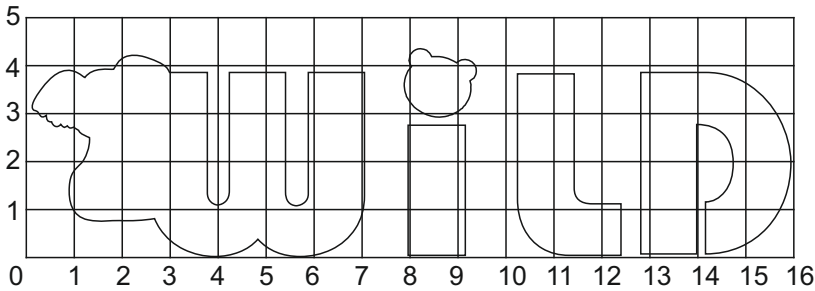
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Graphic designers are often asked to produce a range of drawings of the same object - drawn to scale. The technique below explains how this can be achieved.

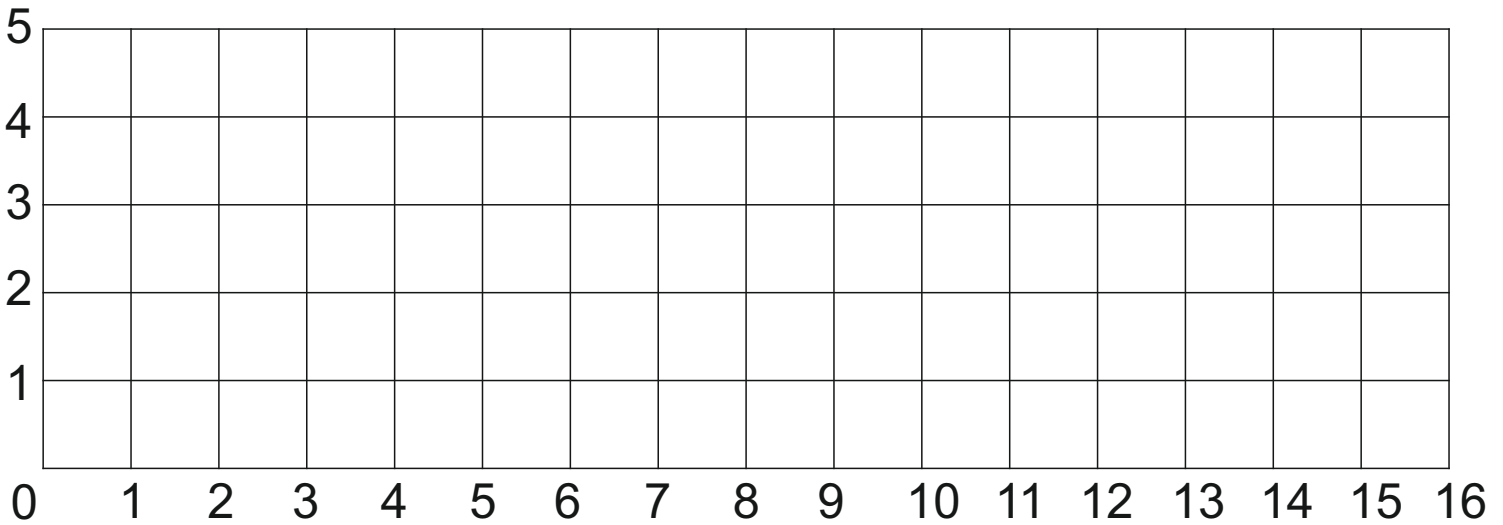


1. Opposite is the word 'WILD', drawn graphically with colour and shade.



2. A grid has been draw around the outline of the 'WILD' shown above.

3. Draw the enlarged outline in the scaled up grid drawn below. Then add appropriate colour and shade.
