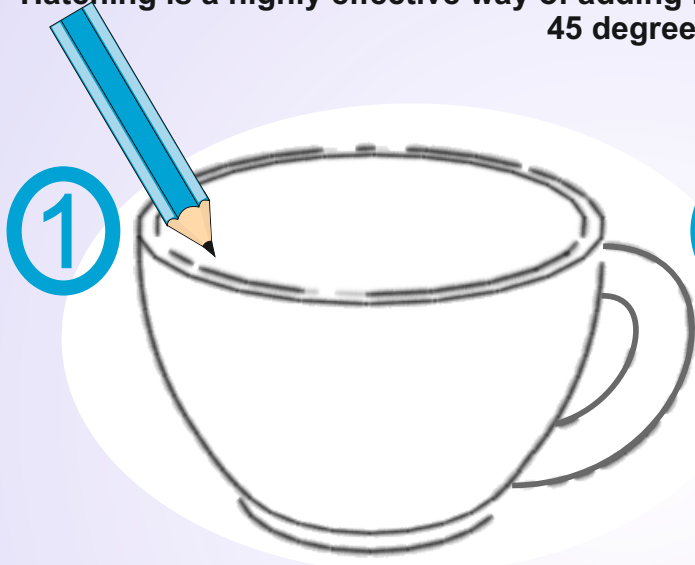


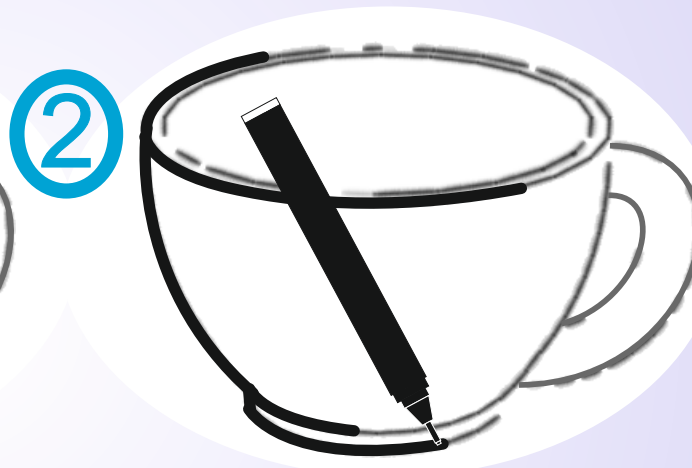
# THICK AND THIN LINES AND HATCHING TECHNIQUE

Hatching is a highly effective way of adding limited shade to a sketch / drawing. Hatching lines are normally at an angle, between 60 to 45 degrees. They should be fainter than the outline of the sketch.



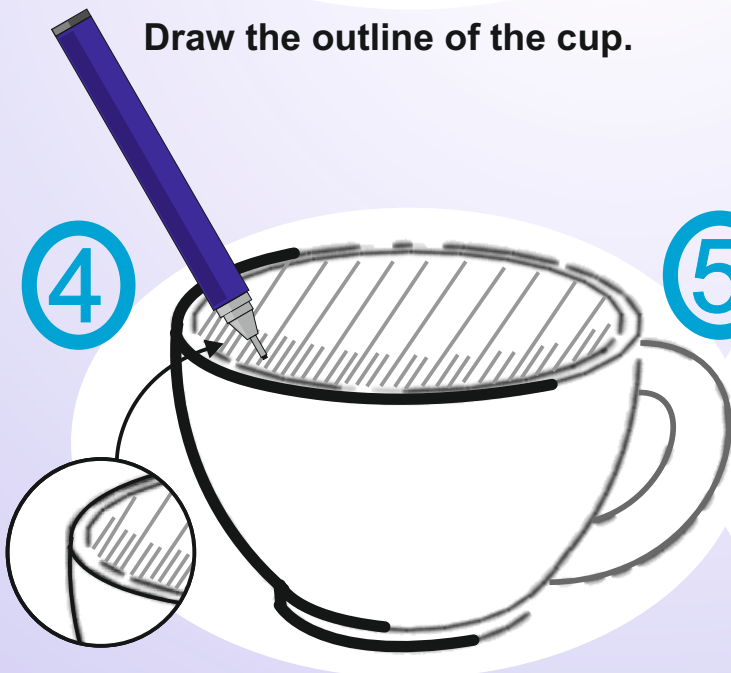
1 Draw the outline of the cup.



2 Add the darker lines by applying more weight.

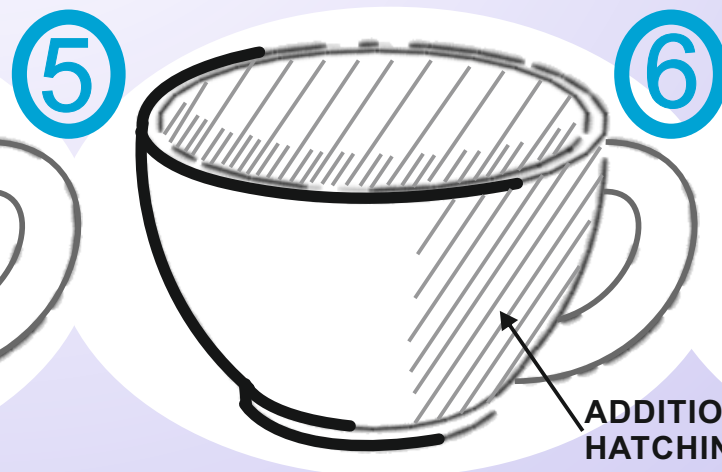


3 Add hatching to the internal part of the cup.

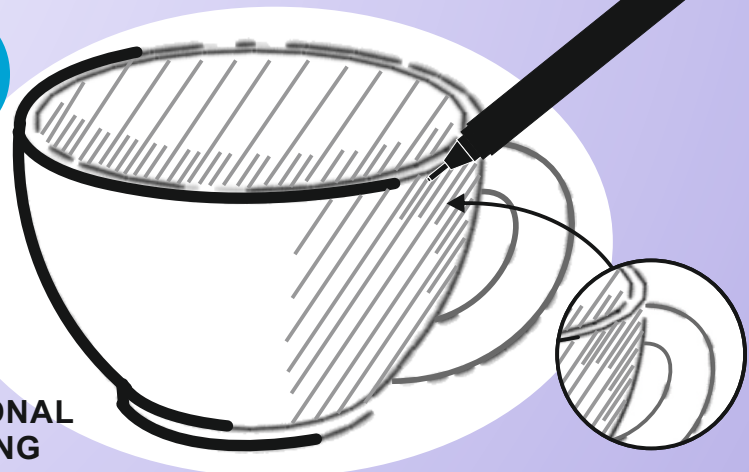


4 Add further hatching - short lines

5 Draw further hatching lines on the right hand side of the cup.



6 Add shorter hatching lines to the right hand corner, near the handle.
