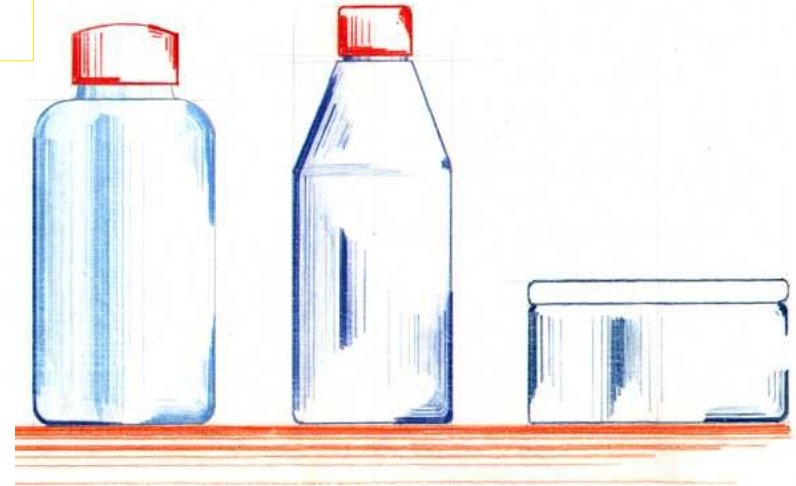
EXERCISE 1

Study the shading of the sample bottles. Then, apply the same style of shading to the outline drawings below. Follow the links for hints and guidance.

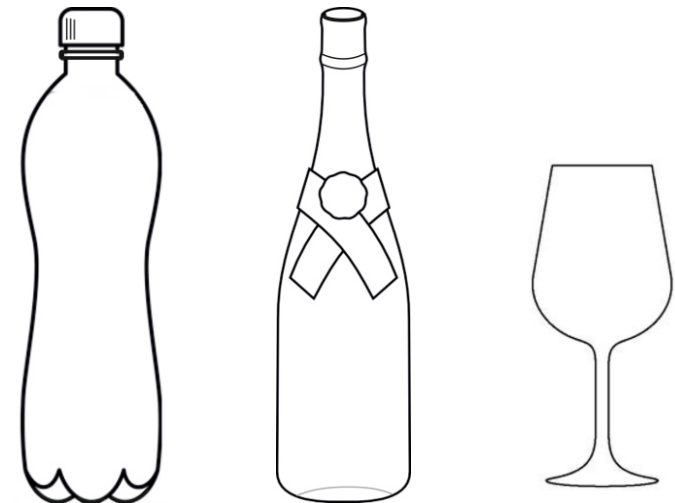

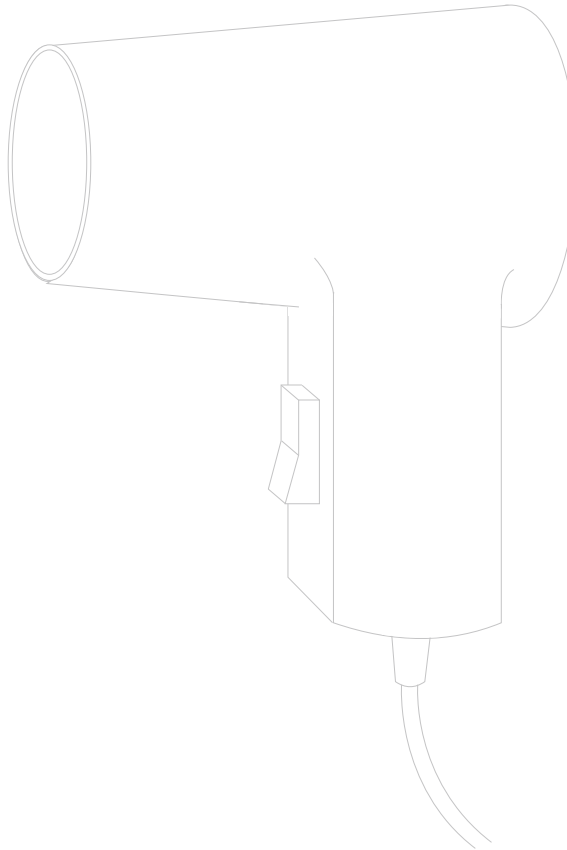
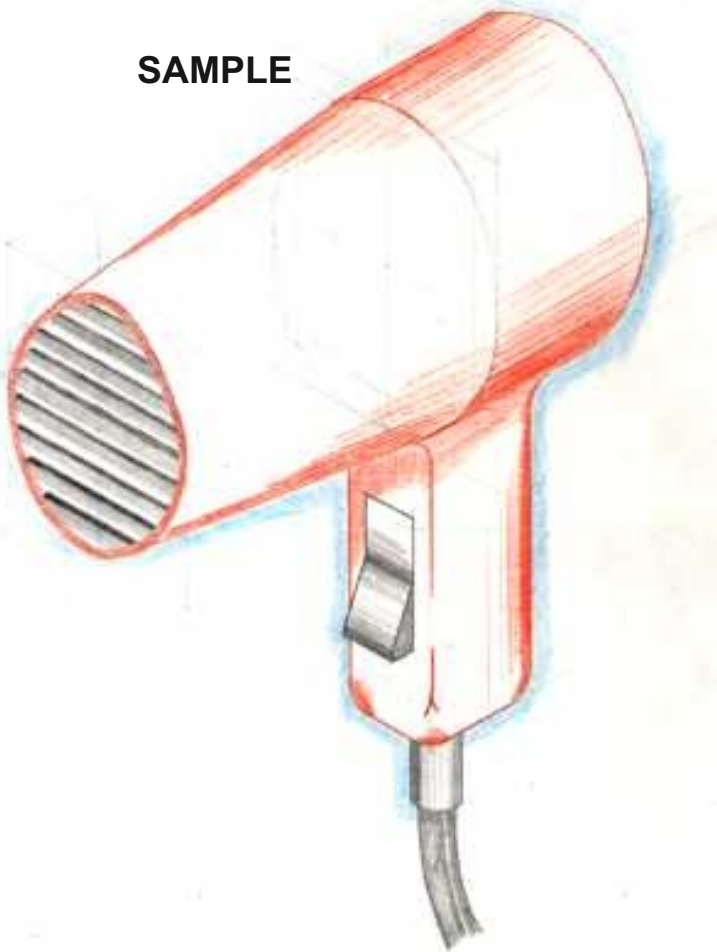
EXERCISE 2
