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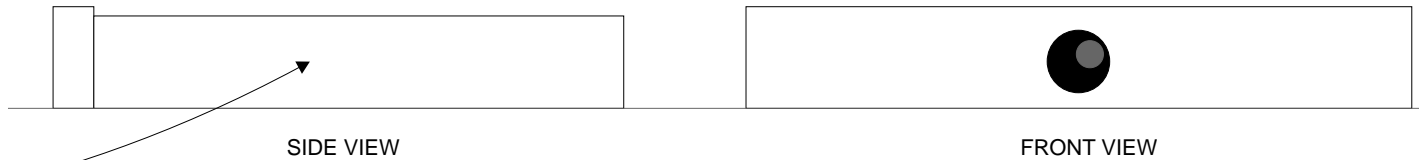

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TRADITIONAL DESK ORGANISER

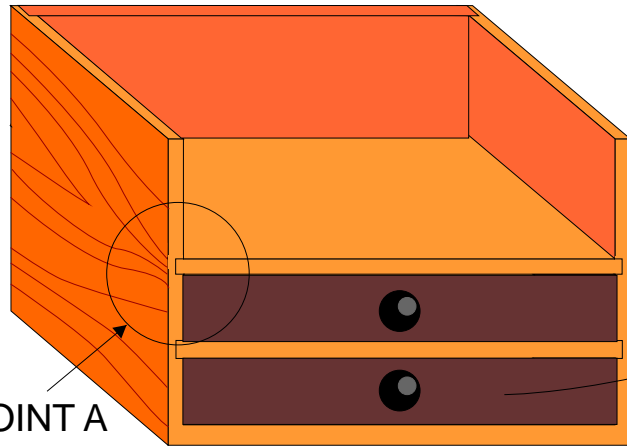
The diagram opposite shows a typical traditional desk organiser, designed to hold stationery equipment. It has two drawers with handles.
