

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## **STEEL WELDING PROCEDURE - FLAT PLATES**

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The table below should show the stages involved in welding flat steel plates. Complete the table by adding the missing text / descriptions and sketches.

STAGE DESCRIPTION	SKETCH
<b>1.</b> The two steel plates are 'tacked' together. This involves welding in two or three places, to hold the plates together.	
2.	
<b>3.</b> The joint is allowed to cool slowly. When cool, the 'slag', which forms during the welding process, is tapped away using a welding hammer. The joint can now be inspected for accuracy and strength.
