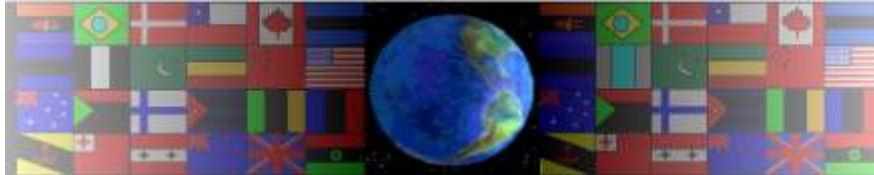

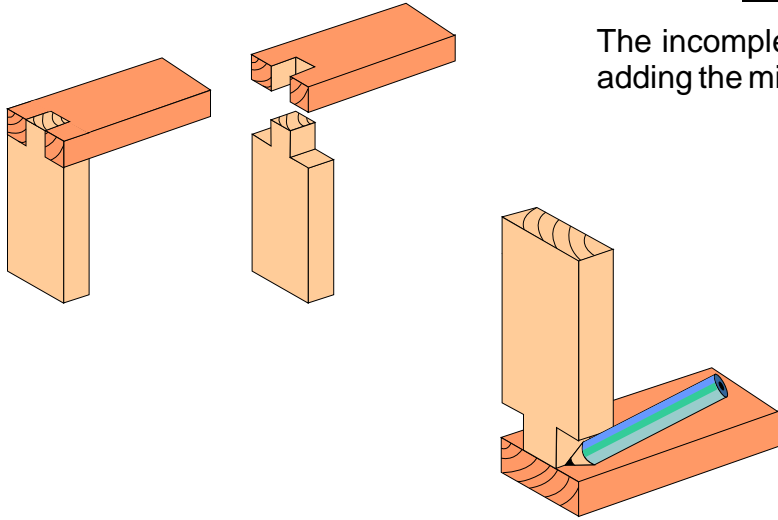

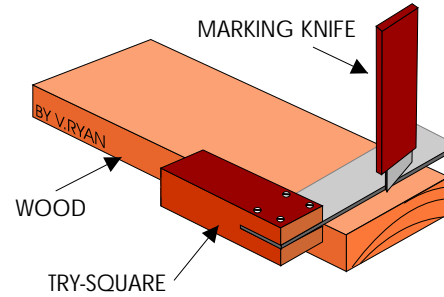
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FINGER JOINTS - PART TWO

The incomplete stages of marking out and cutting a typical finger/comb joint. Complete the stages by adding the missing descriptions and drawings.

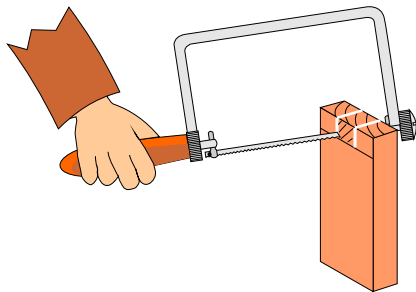

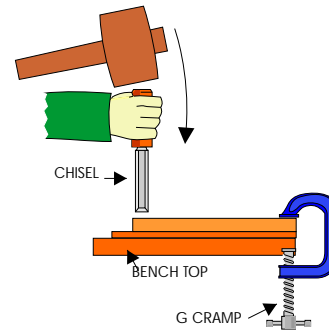

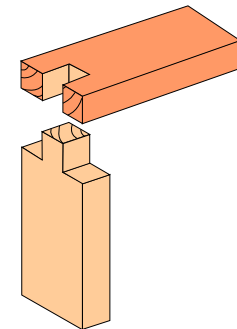
