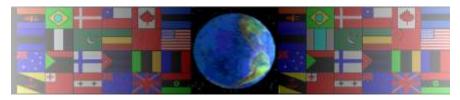

Design the packaging to a product of your choice, using the cuboid development / net on this sheet.

You will need to:

- 1. Select a product and create a suitable name. You may want to create a new product. Add the name to the net in a style of writing that suits the product.
- 2. Add pictures / images. These may be scenes or pictures of the product.
- 3. Add a logo / symbol that represents the company manufacturing the product. E.g. Cadburys or Kelloggs etc...
- 4. Add a safety symbol such as the British Standards or European Standards symbols.
- 5. Add a bar code.
- 6. Add a list / table of ingredients. You may need access to the internet OR use an old wrapper of a similar product, to collect the information.
- 7. Add a manufacturers address and consumer services information.
- 8. Add use by date.
- 9. Apply a suitable colour scheme.
