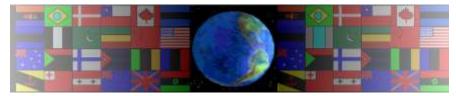


Study the Moodboard carefully.

For the product you have chosen:


A. Draw a design that would interest a teenager.
