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
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
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
## MARKING OUT AND CUTTING THE TENON






A SPURS OF A MORTISE GAUGE ARE SET TO THE CORRECT DISTANCE, MATCHING THE WIDTH OF THE MORTISE CHISEL







ONCE MARKING OUT IS COMPLETE AND CHECKED A TENON SAW IS USED TO CUT THE TENON.

A CHISEL IS USED TO CLEAN / STRAIGHTEN THE SIDES OF THE TENON ENSURING IT IS ACCURATE
