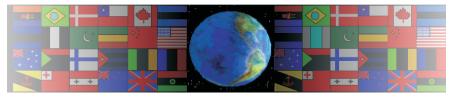



USING A T-SQUARE AND SET SQUARE

Set up this paper on a drawing board using a T-Square to ensure that the paper is straight. Use board clips or masking tape to hold it firmly to the board. Then using a T-square, draw more horizontal lines from the bottom of the page upwards.

Finally use a T-square in conjunction with a set square to draw more vertical lines across the page from right to left.
